

personnel. Inhalation: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferable mouth-to-mouth. Consult medical personnel. Ingestion: Give one or more glasses of water to drink and induce vomiting by sticking finger down back of throat. Repeat until vomit is clear. Get immediate medical attention. If activated charcoal is available, administer. Skin: Wash material off of skin with plenty of soap and water. If redness occurs or material contacts a skin cut or area of abrasion, get medical attention. Wash contaminated clothing and decontaminate footwear before reuse. Note to physician: Call 1-800-FASTMED (327-8633) to obtain medical and toxicology information. To be effective, treatment for diquat poisoning must begin immediately. Treatment consists of binding diquat in the gut with suspensions of activated charcoal or bentonite clay, administration of cathartics to enhance elimination, and removal of diquat from blood by charcoal hemoperfusion or continuous dialysis.

Section VII Precautions for Safe Handling and Use

Steps to be taken in case material is released or spilled	Use adequate ventilation or wear an air-supplied respirator to prevent inhalation. Wear suitable protective clothing and eye protection to prevent skin or eye contact. Do not allow material to enter streams, sewers or other waterways. Spread a suitable absorbent such as clay on the spill, and shovel into an open drum. Generously cover the contaminated area with common household detergent. Using a stiff brush and small amounts of water, work the detergent into the remaining spilled material forming a slurry. Allow to stand for 2-3 minutes. Spread absorbent on the slurry liquid and shovel mixture into open drum. Rinse with small amount of water and use absorbent to collect. Shovel into open drum. Seal drum and dispose of contaminated material in a facility permitted by hazardous waste. Large spills should be handled according to a spill plan. In case of emergency, day or night, call 800-424-6300, Chemtrec.
Waste disposal method	According to local pollution ordinances. Do not contaminate waterways or potable water supplies.
Precautions For Storing And Handling	Keep out of reach of children. Keep containers closed during storage. Read entire label for complete cautions and use directions. Do not store near food, feed, or other pesticides or fertilizers.
Other Precautions	Keep children and pets out of treated areas.
